Class Description:

Knit a slip-on cozy for your coffee mug with as many stripes as you like! You will learn: how to knit in the round with a circular needle and the Magic Loop technique (no seams!!), 2x2 ribbing, jogless joins for your stripes and extra stretchy techniques for casting on & binding off.

*Children ages 12 and up are welcome to take this class.
