



Tatting: Learn the Basics Workshop

Supply List

Class Description:

Learn the stitches and techniques that are the foundation of all tatting projects; the double stitch, rings, chains, and picots. Leave class with a beautiful pair of snowflake earrings.

Required Supplies

- Tatting Shuttle – (preferably with a hook on one end and a removable bobbin).
- If you have an older shuttle that doesn't have the hook and removable bobbin, that is fine, but you will also need a **small crochet hook**.
- #8, #10 or #12 weight thread/string in your choice of color. #5 will also work, your project will be a little bit larger than the samples.
- Scissors

- Magnifier or reading glasses (if needed)
- Fabric stiffener: Aleen's Fabric Stiffener, Plaid Stiffy, Beacon Stiffen Stuff are available in the Craft Department.

Optional Supplies

- An additional shuttle for intermediate projects/techniques and extra bobbins for changing color and threads

Workshop Policies
