



Learn to Knit in the Round – Barley Hat

Supply List

Workshop Description:

While knitting Tin Can Knits' Barley Hat, you will learn to knit in the round on circular and double pointed needles, and how to decrease. You will also begin to use pattern reading skills. The pattern is written for sizes baby through adult, so after you finish your first hat, you'll be ready to knit it again in any size!

Workshop Prerequisites:

Beginning knitting or equivalent experience – you have experience with both knit and purl stitches.

Required Supplies:

- 70 - 170 yards worsted to aran weight yarn. Use pattern to determine yardage based on size. Sample worked in **Lion Brand Scarfie**. If you choose yarn in a hank, please wind in prior to class.

- Locking stitch markers
- US #6 16" circular knitting needle
- US #8 16" circular knitting needle
- US #8 5" double pointed knitting needles
- 2¾" plastic yarn needle
- Scissors
- Ruler or tape measure
- Pen or pencil
