



Learn to Knit Socks Workshop

Workshop Description:

You'll be surprised how quickly you can knit a pair of socks using worsted weight yarn. [Tin Can Knits' Rye Socks](#) pattern is perfect for the beginning sock knitter with lots of pictures and tutorials. Using double pointed needles, you'll learn top down sock construction, k2tog and ssk decreases, how to pick up stitches and more. The pattern is written for baby through adult sizes, so after you finish your first pair, you'll be ready to knit a pair for everyone in your family!

Workshop Prerequisites:

You know how to cast on, knit, purl, and also have experience with reading patterns and knitting in the round.

Required Supplies:

- 150-350 yards of worsted to aran weight yarn.
Sample (child sized) was worked in **Plymouth Encore**.
- Download pattern from <https://www.ravelry.com/patterns/library/rye-4>
- Locking stitch markers
- 2¾" plastic yarn needle
- Scissors
- Ruler or tape measure
- Pen or pencil
- US #3 - 5" double pointed needles
- US #5 - 5" double pointed needles
