



## Supply List

### Workshop Description:

This workshop is designed for everyone who wants to paint with watercolors: Brand new students who have taken the Beginning Watercolor Workshop, as well as those with some experience or those who are advanced. Each studio workshop session is designed to present a particular topic/technique in a brief demonstration by the instructor and then allows free time to work on a piece of your own subject matter with the technique presented or of a subject of your choosing. In either case, the instructor will move around the room allowing ample time for individual attention. Be sure to bring reference material or photos of subjects that interest you. The instructor will plan to have demonstrations ready to present. However, as the studio workshops progress, input from the students or requests to cover certain topics or techniques will be welcomed.

**Age Requirement:** This workshop is open to ages 16 and up.

**Required Supplies – these are the items required for the Beginning Watercolor students. You may bring other items as needed for your particular project.**

#### Items to purchase

- Arches 140 lbs. cold pressed watercolor paper, 1/4 sheet (Do not buy Arches blocks)
- Watercolor paint in tubes: Grumbacher, Cotman or Windsor Newton. Colors needed: sap green, ultramarine blue, alizarin crimson and cadmium yellow (Art kit dry sets or any other brand not listed are not suitable for this workshop)
- Brushes: round brush no. 3 or 4, flat ½” or ¾” inch brush (can be angled)
- Kneaded eraser
- Foam core board (1/2 sheet)

#### Items from home

- 2 or 3 white styrofoam dinner plates *or* optional watercolor paint palette
- 1-1/2” wide blue painter’s masking tape
- Stapler
- Pencil/scratch paper
- Paper toweling
- Water container
- Spray bottle
- Q-tips
- Optional : hair dryer
